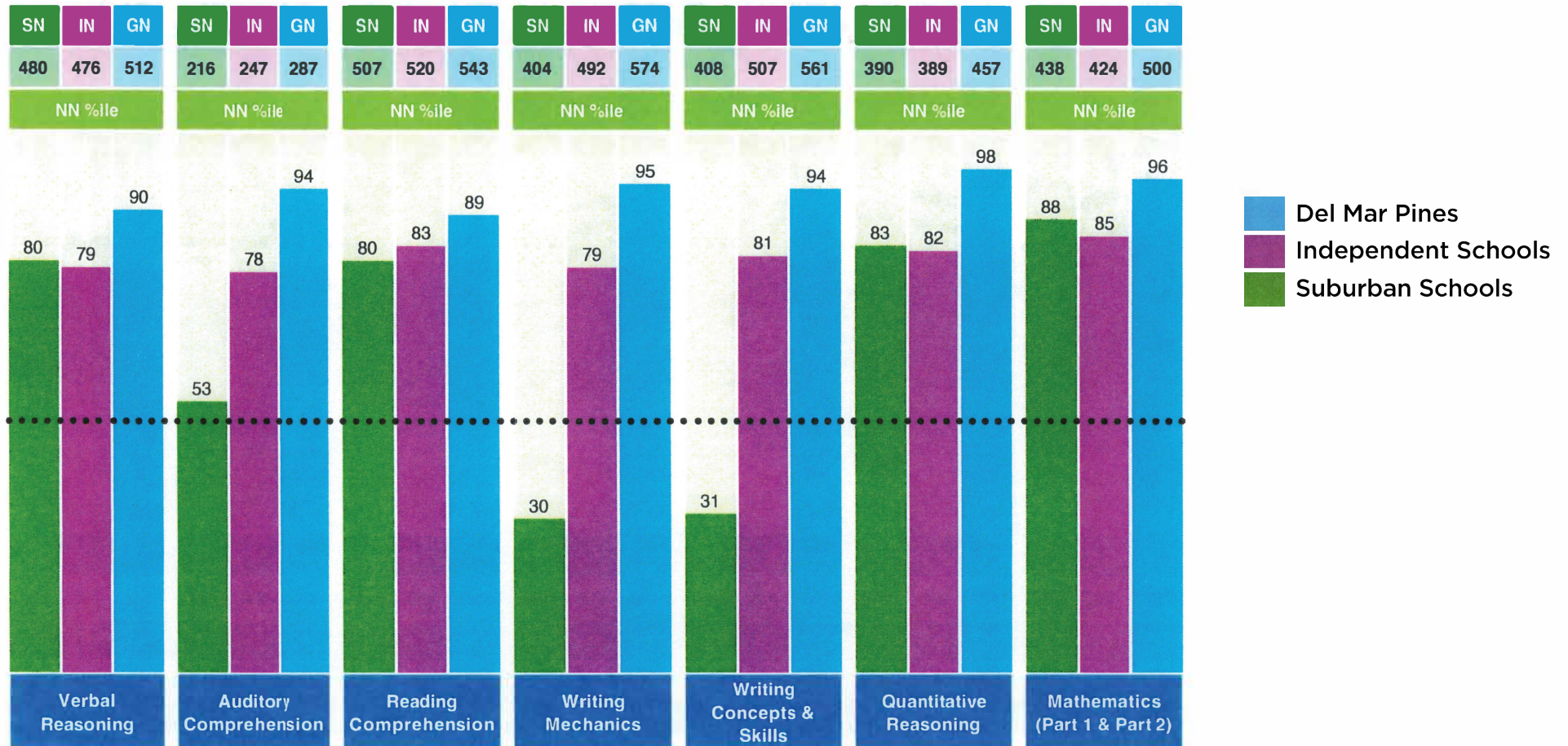


Median Scale Scores and National Percentile Ranks

The chart below reports the median scale scores by subtest for all of the students in a given grade at your school ("GN" values), as well as the median scores for up to two norm groups. Remember that the median represents the midpoint of a distribution of scores, not an average. The chart displays the national percentile ranks of these median scale scores. For comparison, the dotted line presents the 50th percentile of the national norm group. Use this report to understand how typical performance at your school compares to that of norm groups.

CN = Local Class Norm DN = Local District Norm NN = National Norm SN = Suburban Norm IN = Independent Norm

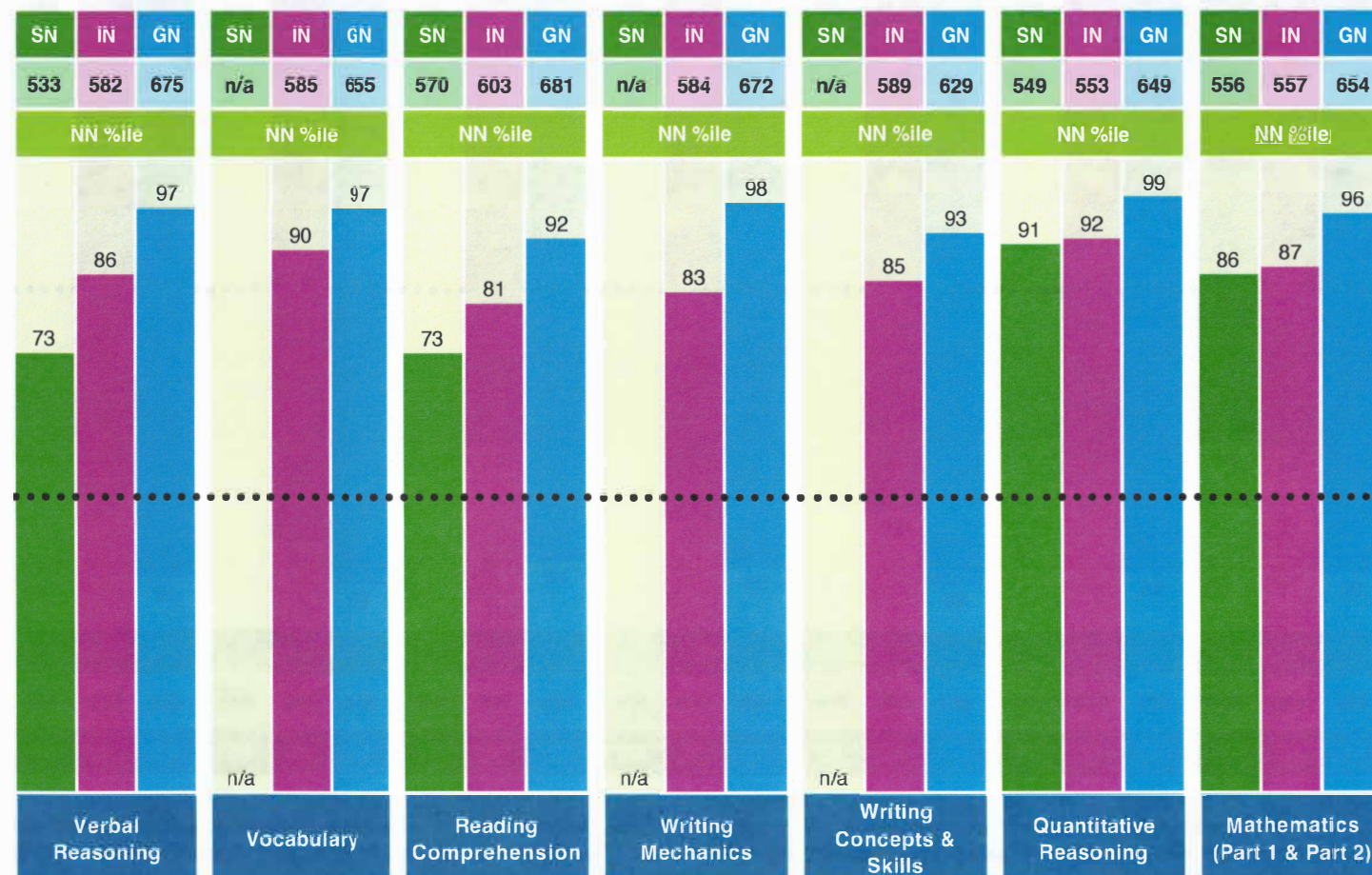
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
